Species: Walleye pollock (Gadus (Theragra) chalcogrammus)
Gear: Mid-water (pelagic) trawl

Geographical area: FAO 61 - 01 West Bering Sea Zone (east of 174 E to the delimiting line between Russia and the United States).

Chain of Custody: The change of ownership occurs at the point of landing (designated port, Russian or foreign after clearance at the Russian port) at which time ownership transfers to processors / buyers.

Eligible points of landing: According to Russian law all fish or processed fish produced must be delivered to Russian ports for clearance before onward delivery. The eligible points of landing are the Russian ports where fish is delivered for clearance, including but not exclusively Vladivostok and Petropavlovsk-Kamchatskiy. Note that catch is transshipped from catcher boats at sea to the reefer vessels for onward delivery to the ports designated. After clearance, the reefer vessels deliver the products for export to foreign ports.
